Vacancy at MAP Foundation for Migrant Youth Project Officer, Mae Sot

MAP Foundation is a Thai NGO working since 1996 to promote the rights of migrant workers from Burma working in construction, agriculture, domestic work and factories. We are currently looking for a Migrant Youth Project Officer for a project under the “Rights for All Program” focusing on empowering migrant youth. The Project Officer will be based in Mae Sot.

The Project Officer will work with a small team of volunteers onsite, coordinate with MAP’s multimedia program and will report to the Rights for All Program Coordinator. The Project Officer will be responsible for:

- Outreach to agricultural migrant communities in Mae Ramat and selected communities in Mae Sot
- Setting up and organizing activities in drop in centres
- Broadcasting and organizing migrant youth to broadcast on MAP’s radio show
- Organising workshops and youth camps for migrant youth
- Coordinate with the multi-media coordinator and MAP’s partners to produce written and audio materials for migrant youth.
- Working with a team (MAP, FED, and PLAN international) to write a situational analysis.
- Writing reports and updates.
- Liaising with relevant stakeholders (GOs, NGOs, UN agencies etc) and advocating on behalf of migrant communities

We are looking for someone who:

- Has commitment, enthusiasm and initiative
- Is fluent in Burmese, and also preferably Thai and/or Karen and/or English
- Has at least 3 years experience of working in community development and empowerment
- Has knowledge of sexual and reproductive health issues and gender power issues
- Is computer literate and has creative capacity to write radio scripts and materials with youth
- Has the ability to develop the capacity and empower a team of migrant youth
- Preference will be given to candidates holding a current driving licence

We are looking for someone to start as soon as possible. The Project is supported for 2 years 9 months. The Position will be initially for nine months with the possibility of extension for two more years. Salary will be in the range of 10,000 baht – 15,000 baht depending on qualifications, years of relevant experience and language and skills.
